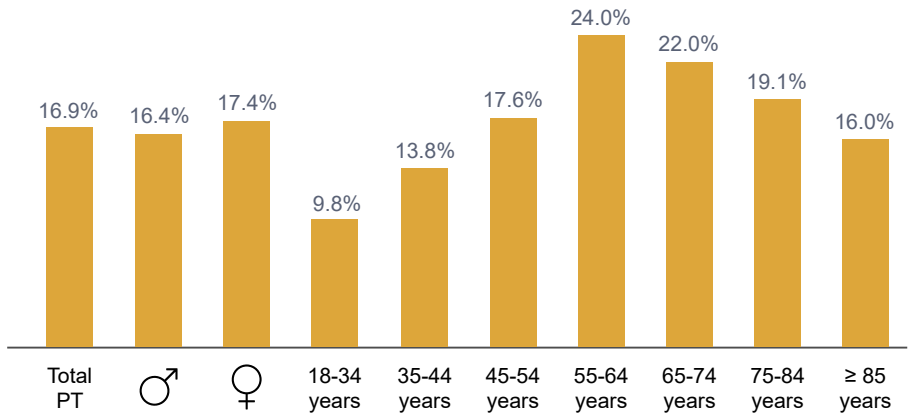

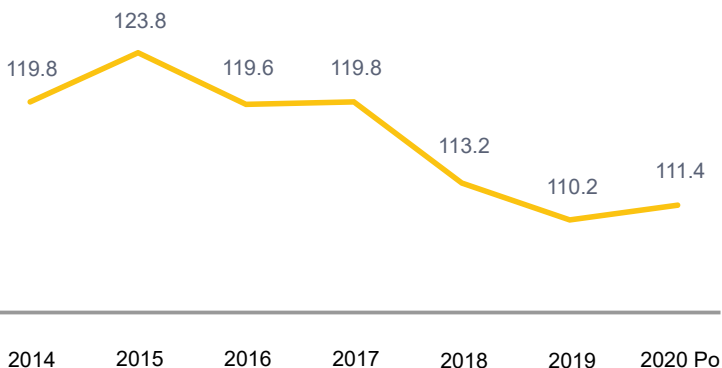

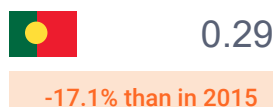
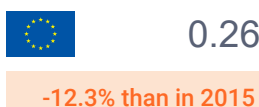
Manufacturing value added as a proportion of GDP

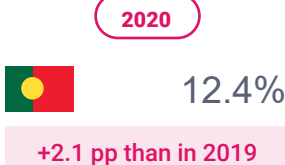

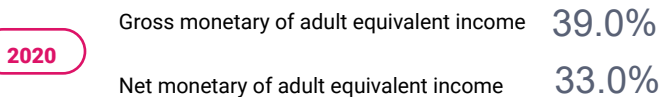


Share of the compensation of employees in GDP

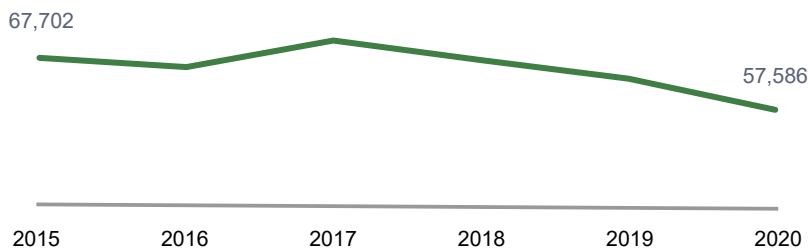

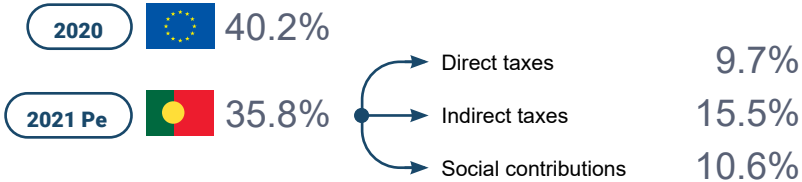

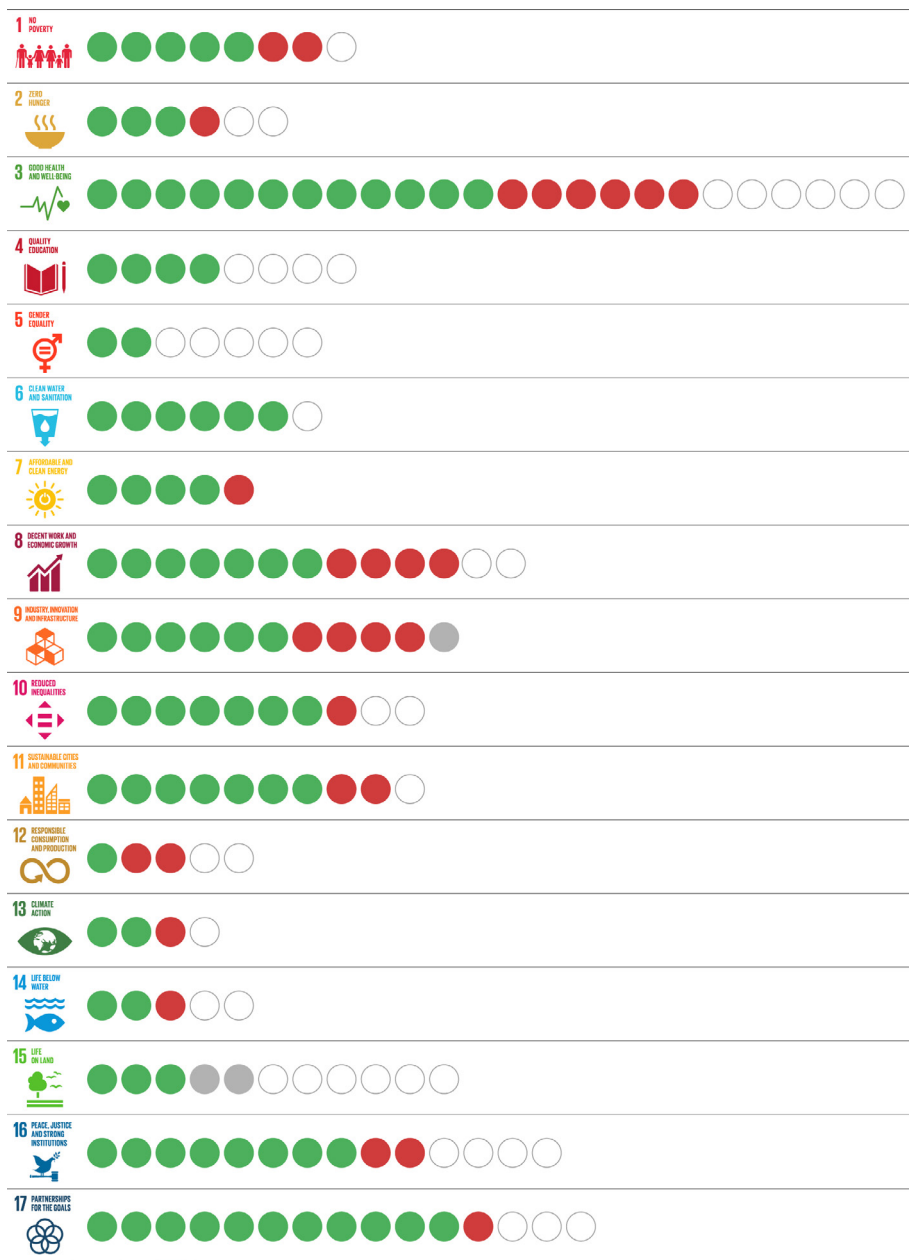

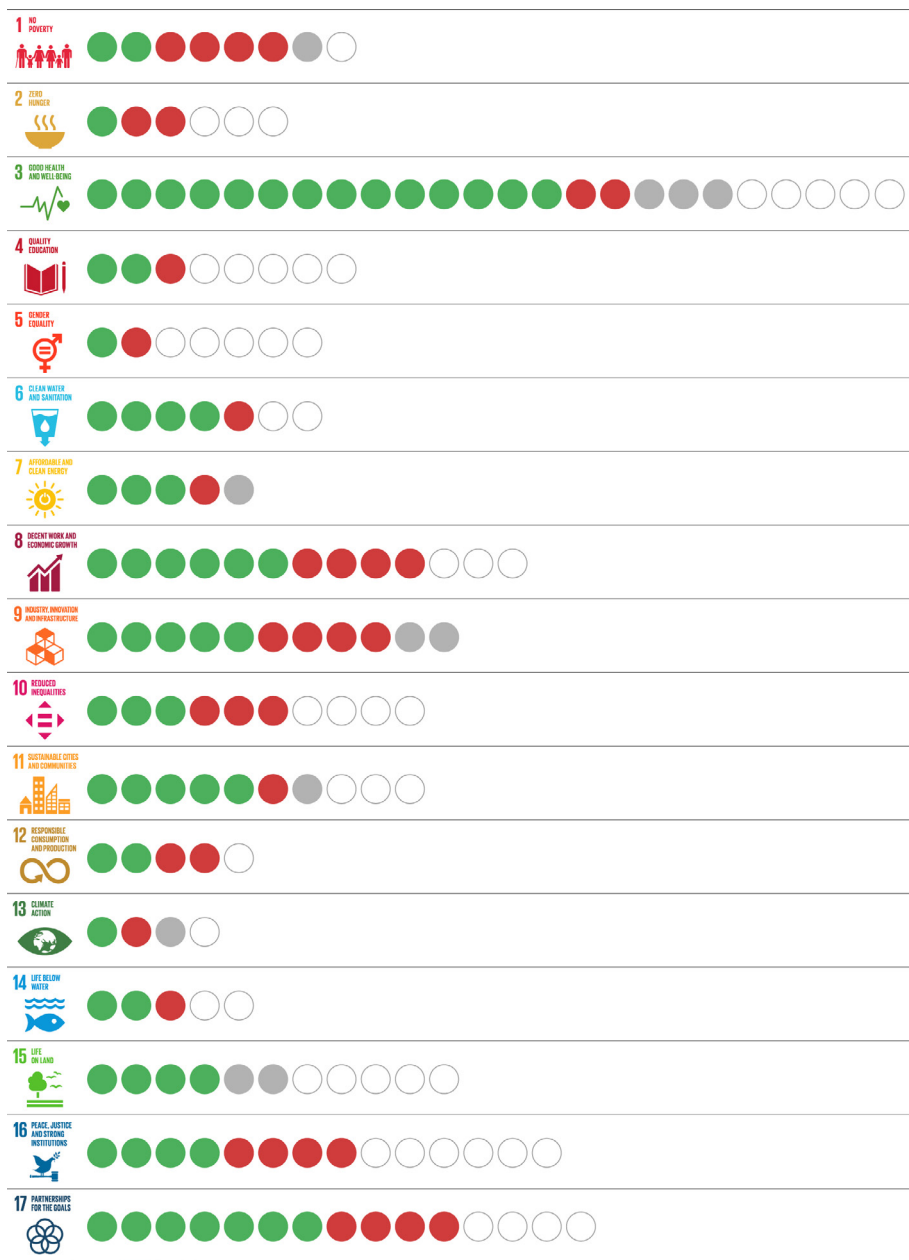
