Information and Communication Technologies Usage in Households and by Individuals:

Individuals aged 10 to 15 years

2005-2008

97% Of individuals aged 10 and 15 years use computers, 93% access the Internet and 85% use mobile phone

In the first quarter of 2008, more than 90% of individuals aged between 10 and 15 years used computer (96.6%) and Internet (92.7%), while the use of mobile phone stood at 84, 6%.

Use of Information Technology and Communication

In the first quarter of 2008, 96.6% of individuals aged between 10 and 15 years used computer and Internet 92.7%, while the use of mobile phone stood at 84.6% in this age group.

From 2005 to 2008, there is in the age group of 10 to 15 years an increase in the proportion of users of computer and Internet, particularly the use of the Internet (from 73.5% to 92.7%). The use of mobile phone increases at between 2007 and 2008 in more than 11 percentage points (from 73.3% to 84.6%).
